

2016 FAMILY VOLUNTEER DAY SHARE YOUR STORY SWEEPSTAKES

OFFICIAL RULES

Important: Please read these Official Rules before entering this sweepstakes (the "Sweepstakes"). By submitting an entry and participating in the Sweepstakes, you agree to be bound by these Official Rules and represent that you satisfy all of the eligibility requirements below.

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN THIS SWEEPSTAKES.

1. **Sponsor/Administrator:** This Sweepstakes is sponsored by Points of Light Foundation d/b/a Points of Light Institute, 600 Means Street NW, Suite 210, Atlanta, Georgia 30318 ("Sponsor"). The Sweepstakes is administered by GenerationOn, a program of Sponsor, located at 35 W 35th Street, 6th Floor, New York City, NY 10001 ("Administrator"), on behalf of Sponsor. 2. **Eligibility:** The Sweepstakes is offered and open only to persons legally residing in one of the fifty (50) United States or Washington DC who are at least 18 (eighteen) years of age or the age of majority in their state of residence on the date of entry in the Sweepstakes. The directors, officers and employees of Sponsor and Administrator, and each of their respective parents, subsidiaries and affiliated companies, distributors, advertising, promotional and, persons engaged in the development, production or distribution of materials for this sweepstakes and the immediate family members (parent, child, sibling and spouse of each) of, and/or other persons (whether related or not) living in the same household as, such individuals are not eligible to participate in the Sweepstakes. The Sweepstakes is void in Puerto Rico, all US territories and possessions, and where prohibited by law.
3. **Sweepstakes Entry Period:** The Sweepstakes starts October 30, 2016 at 12:00:00 PM Eastern Time (ET) and ends December 3, 2015 at 11:59:59 AM ET (the "Sweepstakes Period"). All entries must be received during the Sweepstakes Period and meet the other requirements in these Official Rules to be eligible to potentially win a prize.
4. **Prizes:**
 - (a) **Grand Prize Description:** Each of four (4) grand prizes will consist of one (1) \$500 gift card issued by VISA® subject to the terms and conditions of the issuer, which has no affiliation with the Sponsor or Administrator.
 - (b) **Runner-up Prize Description:** Each of 5 (5) runner-up prizes will consist of the following costs associated with a family night out comprising: A \$100 restaurant gift card that can be used at a range of outlets; plus a \$60 "Fandango" gift card (or equivalent). The gift card(s) will be selected by the Administrator in its sole discretion.
5. The Approximate Retail Value (ARV) of each of the Grand Prizes is \$500. The ARV of each of the Runner-up prizes is \$160. Total ARV of all Sweepstakes prizes is \$2,800.00.

Prizes are non-assignable and non-transferable. No prize substitutions by the winners allowed. Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to substitute a prize of equal or greater value if advertised Prizes become unavailable. Prizes may not be sold, bartered, redeemable for cash or exchanged by the winners. All details of the prizes not specified herein shall be determined solely by Sponsor. All federal, state or other tax liabilities arising from the Prizes awarded in connection with the Sweepstakes are the sole responsibility of the prize winners. The grand prize winner will be issued an IRS Tax Form 1099 reporting the fair market value of the prize for 2016 tax filing purposes, and the winner will be required to provide their social security number as a condition for claiming the prize. (The Walt Disney Company is not affiliated with the Sweepstakes and assumes no liability with respect to any of the prizes or the Sweepstakes.) All prizes will be awarded provided a sufficient number of eligible entries are received.

6. **How To Enter:** To enter the Sweepstakes, take the following steps during the Sweepstakes Period:

- Step 1: Visit the Family Volunteer Day microsite at www.generationon.org/fvd;
- Step 2: Submit your family's story of service on the Family Volunteer Day microsite; and
- Step 3: Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the entry form provided and upload a photo.

If any entrant is found to have used multiple or different entries, entries are defined by submissions associated with an email account, such entrant will be disqualified in the Administrator's sole discretion. Limit one (1) entry per person throughout the Sweepstakes Period. All requested information including a photo must be provided to Sponsor for entrant's entry to be valid). All entries must be legible and in English or Spanish. Entries become the exclusive property of Sponsor and will not be acknowledged or returned. All entrants and entries are subject to verification by Sponsor. Sponsor's computer is the official timekeeper for the Sweepstakes.

7. **Prize Drawings:** A random drawing to select the prize winners from among all eligible entries received will be conducted by Administrator at 35 West 35th Street, floor 6, New York City, NY 10001 on or about December 3rd, 2016. The decisions made by Administrator are final and binding in all matters relating to the Sweepstakes. Odds of winning are subject to the total number of eligible entries received by the entry deadline.
8. **Notification of Winners:** Administrator will notify the potential winners by regular mail, email or phone at the postal address, email address or daytime phone number provided with the entry within **three (3) business days** of the drawing date. The potential winners will be required to complete and return an Affidavit of Eligibility/Liability Release, and, where legal, a Publicity Release, within **three (3) business days** of issuance of notification of its winner status. An entrant's failure to complete and return any required information and/or documents in the time noted, or the

Administrator's inability to provide a potential winner notification of the fact that he or she is a potential winner, will result in disqualification of the potential winner involved and an alternate winner will be selected and notified.

9. **Entry Conditions:** All entrants will be required on the entry form to indicate that they have read, accepted and agree to be bound by these Official Rules, and that they are at least eighteen (18) years of age or the age of majority in their state of residence. Any individual who attempts to enter or is, in the sole discretion of Administrator, suspected of entering the Sweepstakes more than once, by any means, including but not limited to establishing multiple e-mail accounts, will be disqualified from participation in the Sweepstakes or in any future sweepstakes. In the event of a dispute over the identity of any potential winner, the entry will be declared to have been made by the authorized account holder of the email address submitted at the time of entry, and the potential winner may be required to provide identification and other evidence sufficient to show to Administrator's satisfaction that he/she was the authorized account holder of such email address at the relevant time. It is the sole responsibility of the entrant to notify Administrator in writing if the entrant changes his or her email or postal address during the Sweepstakes Period. Proof of emailing does not constitute proof of delivery or entry. Each entry submission must be manually key stroked and manually entered by the individual entrant. Automated and/or repetitive electronic submissions of entries (including but not limited to entries made using any script, macro, bot, or sweepstakes service) will be disqualified and transmissions from these or related email or IP addresses may be blocked. All entries become the property of Sponsor and will not be returned to the entrants.
10. **Conduct:** The Sweepstakes is subject to all federal, state and local laws and regulations. By entering the Sweepstakes, entrants agree to be bound and to abide by these Official Rules and the decisions of Sponsor and/or Administrator, which decisions shall be final and binding in all respects. By accepting a prize, each winner acknowledges compliance with these Official Rules. Failure to comply with these Official Rules may result in disqualification. Sponsor and/or Administrator reserve(s) the right, in their sole discretion, to disqualify any individual suspected of tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Sweepstakes; or acting in any manner deemed by Sponsor and/or Administrator to be in violation of the Official Rules, unsportsmanlike, disruptive or with intent to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass any other person. 11. **Liability Release:** To the fullest extent permitted by law, all entrants, as a condition of entry into the Sweepstakes, agree to release and hold Sponsor, Administrator and Disney Worldwide Services, and their respective employees, officers, directors, parents,

subsidiaries, affiliates, divisions, distributors, suppliers, printers, application developers, distributors and advertising, promotional and/or judging agencies, and each of the foregoing harmless from and against any and all liability, loss, cost, expenses, claims or actions of any kind whatsoever for injuries, damages or losses to persons or property that may be sustained in connection with (a) accessing the Sweepstakes page; (b) submitting an entry or otherwise participating in any aspect of the Sweepstakes; (c) the receipt, ownership or use of any prize awarded; (d) preparing for, participating in or traveling to and/or from any prize-related activity; or (e) any typographical or other error in these Official Rules or the announcement or offering of any prize. Sponsor makes no representations or warranties of any kind whatsoever concerning the appearance, safety or performance of any prize.

16. **Governing Law:** All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of these Official Rules, or the rights and obligations of Sponsor and Administrator in connection with the Sweepstakes, shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the State of Georgia, without regard for conflicts of law doctrine, and all proceedings shall take place in Fulton County, Georgia. Any and all claims will be resolved individually, without resort to class action.
